IT IS BASED ON THE INTRODUCTION NOT DO, BUT DONE FINISH ED [

Jesus Christ paid the price for humanity on the cross and then He made this statement: "It is finished!" This is probably the most powerful word ever spoken over humanity.

...The unveiling of this eternal secret is to bring into public view an association that has always been hidden in God; Jesus Christ is the blueprint of creation. Ephesians 3:9, The Mirror

So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said: "It is finished!" And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.

John 19:30

IT IS FINISHED!

The Gospel is all about what Jesus Christ did on behalf of humanity - that which we desperately needed, but could not do ourselves.

On the cross Jesus Christ paid the price to redeem humanity. The statement: "It is finished!" - in the Greek *tetelestai* - is probably the most powerful word ever spoken over the human race.

Words have power. A single word can keep you captive, it can define the way you approach life. Words have influence and repositioning power.

The word *tetelestai* is the final word spoken over every human life. No word should have a stronger effect on how you live your life than these words: "It is finished!"

You are included in that proclamation in a reference that

has fundamentally repositioned your life and it becomes effective when you discover its implications.

You are called to this incredible reference of understanding that Jesus Christ did everything on your behalf. You cannot fix or save yourself.

Man's best effort cannot restore the damage in man. You can do your best to make yourself better, but you can never really effectively deal with guilt and shame - for that you need a saviour.

The blood of Jesus Christ is the only power that can address the guilt and shame and its effect in your life.

As you consider the Gospel, the good news is that it is not something you still have to do, but it has already been done on your behalf! The question now is: How then do you position yourself in response to this accomplished work that Jesus did on your behalf? The answer is: you start at what Christ has finished!

You must discover that the reward of Christianity is not heaven. Although it includes heaven it is so much more than heaven.

The reward of Christianity is eternal life. Eternal life is not something you inherit one day when you die, it refers to the restoration of your intimate relationship with the Father. Through Jesus Christ, you can live intertwined with God and this is something you can partake in now, in this life, here on earth.

When you discover this truth it repositions you to take hold of a new way of living life to the full. You cannot earn this by your own religious diligence – Jesus did it on your behalf.

If you do not understand that the price has been paid and that you are included in an accomplished reality, you will still try to do something to qualify, and that will result in the following:

- WORKS when you still think that what you do will qualify you for greater acceptance and a greater sense of righteousness.
- WAVERING when your performance determines your sense of spiritual strength, and because of your inconsistency, God often feels far.
- WORRY when you are concerned whether God will help you and be with you, and even whether you will qualify for heaven.

The problem is that there are too many voices that cloud this vision to truly see what has already been established. One of the strongest voices that you will have to contend with is the convictions that you have because of the way you assume things to be.

The following is crucial in understanding what "not do, but done" means:

- The Gospel is not about trying to get people to adjust their behavior, to make bad people better people. It is about introducing people to the accomplished work of Christ.
- The Gospel is not pedaling moral options for people to try and improve their way of living, it is introducing them to a new reference of life.

The Gospel is about introducing people to this spacious environment called Christ. In Him do we live and move and have our being. Redemption is all about being found in Him!

- Why is the English rhyme "Humpty Dumpty" a metaphor for the state of humanity and the story of the gospel?
- Illustrate with personal examples the applicability of the statement: "The Christian walk of many Christians can be compared to the game of 'Snakes and Ladders'."
- What should your Christian walk look like if you understand the gospel correctly?

IN MY HEART

- 1. Are there any words spoken over your life that is holding you captive in any way?
- Which areas of your Christian walk can still be compared to the game of "Snakes and ladders"?
- 3. Have you already discovered that you are included in the accomplished work and victory of Jesus? What impact does your answer have on your life?



THE POINT OF DEPARTURE: 'IT IS FINISHED!'

Christianity is definitely not about playing spiritual Snakes or Chutes and Ladders in the hope of making the top to reach the "finish" square. The reality you need to discover is that the starting point of our relationship with Jesus is actually the "finish" square. It is not our final destination because we start at "finish."

THE STARTING POINT: "IT IS FINISHED!"

Christ has reached the top of the metaphorical Snakes or Chutes and Ladders board on our behalf. Our spiritual life begins at the FINISH. We start right at the top, at the perfection that Christ has already achieved!

This is the core of the Gospel. If you do not begin from this perspective, your Christian life is going to be one long journey of constant frustration. God wants to make known His eternal, unconditional love for us from this starting point.

In Christ, we already live right at the top, in the "finish"

square, and no chute should ever catch us off guard again. When Jesus Christ cried out, "It is finished!", we were included in an event that changed our entire existence. Our spiritual journey involves discovering our true identity, and that discovery begins when we discover ourselves in Christ and claim His declaration, "It is finished." The game is over – we have won!
